All children from through age 20 years need well child check-ups. A well child check is visiting the doctor or clinic when your child is healthy. When your child is on Medicaid there is no charge for this visit. (Young Adults age 18 and 20 years of age may have a co-pay).

Why Are Well-Child Check-Ups Important?

Babies and children grow quickly. Well-Child check ups help find out if your child has any problems. Well-Child check-ups helps your child stay healthy with immunizations (shots) and will help you learn about changes your has as they grow.

What Happens During a Well-Child Check Up?

The doctor or nurse will:

- Ask about changes since the last well-child check-up.
- Ask about your child health and family life.
- Do an exam that includes:
 - An unclothed physical exam;
 - Weight and measurements;
 - Check your child's vision, hearing and teeth;
 - Give your child any immunizations, (shots) that are needed;
 - Do any needed lab tests (such as a blood count or lead screening).
- Answer any questions you have.
- Help you learn about how your child is groing and changing.
- If there are any problems, the doctor and nurse will help you find care.
